Angela Haver shared handout. Process in line with law enforcement efforts nationally. Taking steps to keep process manageable and learn. It was encouraged that members participate in video workshop. Video available for agencies to view from loan of FCFC office.

**VIII. Agency Sharing**

**Drug Free Youth Coalition-** November is National drug facts month. See blog on website. Adults understanding trends in and language of substance use.

**Children Services-**Intake numbers are up. Family Court numbers up locally and across the state. Anticipate high emergency assistance this winter. Annual adoption event in December. Parenting classes successful, another round starting soon.

**Help Me Grow-** March of Dimes November 6<sup>th</sup>, doing Developmental Screening. Many events finished up this month.

**Department of Youth Services-** Homeless 18/19 year olds coming out of DYS. Many changes happening on state level.

**Lutheran Community Services-** Christmas Basket Program accepting application thru November 12<sup>th</sup>.

**Bellefontaine City Schools-** Renewal levy on ballet this November.

**Board of DD-** November 12<sup>th</sup> 10-2 training “Supporting Sammy” emotional training affects young children’s brain development. Instant replay accepting donations. Various drop off locations at the site, YMCA, and Discovery Center. Expressed thank you for those who supported the Chicken BBQ. Waiting on Budget numbers.

**Educational Service Center-** Surrogate Parent Training in November at Discovery Center.

**Bellefontaine Police Department-** facing significant budget cuts with city. Intense calls of late and police department responded very well.

**Logan BELLE H.A.N.D-** Ribbon cutting for new rental units. They are based permanent supportive housing. Agencies doing supportive services. Eight one bedroom units open in December.

**Project Child-** Huntington Bank doing coat drive for Toasty Tots. Heartland Tree Auction in Nov/Dec.

**Mental Health Drug and Alcohol Services-** Needs up, resources down. Survey Monkey underway, call/email board for a link.

**Consolidated Care Inc. -** 3 year CARF audit underway. 1 staff opening in Logan County. Service numbers are up.

**Department of Job and Family Services-** 2007-2010 food stamp population increased by 90% close to \$10million/year. Spent \$180,000 on clothing to low income families.

**County Commissioner-** Budget planning. Projection of same revenues. Health insurance not going up too much. Document imaging system being considered. Talking with New auditor/ Commissioners to discuss.
